The first letter listed is the letter to the church in Rome. Here are the challenging words to Christian Believers from Romans 12: 1+2 from Dr. David Jeremiah's study bible, (1) "I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God spiritual worship (or vour rational service). (2) Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect." J.B.
