From the Pastor:

"Merry Christmas!" Christmas is celebrated every year. It may have been a tremendously wonderful year or a horribly painful one. It will come proclaiming good news... for all people... everywhere... there is a savior! We may have some personal and family traditions that have survived decades of repetition. The church, as well, celebrates various practices and events that are anticipated and expected - and pastors are cautious to vary them in any significant fashion, risking reactions that can be strong and pointed, even alienating. Each year as we begin the period of Advent, I am reminded that Advent is not simply remembering the anticipation long ago leading up to the birth of Jesus, it is the anticipation that we have today of the return of Jesus yet to come. We'll see soon, if not already by the time you receive your newsletter, the "count-down" to Christmas... 15 days until Christmas... 10 days until Christmas... three days... the last day... We generally have learned to have a count-down to birth... approximately nine months. We are not fooled, however... the birth is just the remarkable beginning of a whole new journey. Too much less than nine months and we call it premature... too much longer and we call it overdue... For centuries the people of God waited for the Messiah, however; they were promised a coming anointed one but no one knew what the gestational period for the coming of a Messiah would be. A week...? A month...? A decade.. century... millennium? It was hope that would fuel their journey forward. It is appropriate that we begin the Advent journey with a theme of "hope." There would be no nine month count-down. There would be no obviously pregnant woman who appearance would entice enthusiasm obviously announcing - "we're getting close." Hope would be something far deeper, something that would develop far more torque to enable people to keep moving through the obstacles, the fear, the mud and mire and challenges of life. Paul chided the Romans to not get hung up on the obvious, but rather to be empowered by faith, hope, and love. He told them in Romans 8: 24 "For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees? 25 But if we hope for what we do not see, through perseverance we wait eagerly for it." In 1 Corinthians 13 he confidently announced: "13 But now faith, hope, and love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love." Faith in the love of God empowers us to confidently live with hope. When advent is restricted to looking to Christmas – it is a shallow journey to a day that quickly comes and passes. When the journey to Christmas is but a primer, a reflection, and a vision - Advent is for us a rally call to live forward with faith, hope, and love on an adventure called the Christian life. It is a dynamic relationship with our living God. The best gift you can every open at Christmas is your heart - open your heart to welcome Jesus in, not to a manger long ago, but to a remarkable life yet to be lived.


