From the Pastor:

THE PRAYER THAT AWAKENED AMERICA

A pastor named Joe Wright delivered the opening prayer at Kansas House of Representatives, following a long-standing tradition.

This prayer, which confessed the sins of the American people, caused a great stir at the time.

As the content of the prayer spread through the media, over 5,000 calls of encouragement reportedly poured into the Central Christian Church where he served.

This prayer, offered on January 23, 1996, continues to resonate powerfully in the hearts if thoughtful Christians even after many years. Here is the full prayer.

Heavenly Father,

We come before you today to ask your forgiveness and seek your direction and guidance.

We know your Word says, "Woe to those who call evil good," (Isaiah 5:20) but that's exactly what we've done.

We have lost our spiritual equilibrium and inverted our values. We have ridiculed the absolute truth of your Word and called it "moral pluralism."

We have worshipped other gods and called it "multiculturalism."

We have endorsed perversion and called it an "alternative lifestyle."

We have exploited the poor and called it the "lottery."

We have neglected the needy and called it "self-preservation."

We have killed our unborn and called it "choice."

We have rewarded laziness and called it "welfare."

We have shot abortionists and called it "justifiable."

We have neglected to discipline our children and called it "building self-esteem."

We have abused power and called it "political savvy."


We have coveted our neighbors' possessions and called it "ambition."

We have polluted the air with profanity and pornography and called it "freedom of expression."

We have ridiculed the time-honored values of our forefathers and called it 'enlightenment.'
